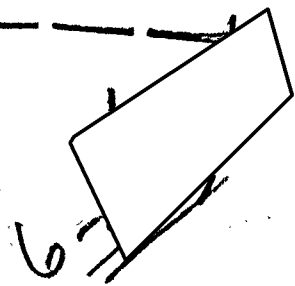

USE OF FORM 0-73

1. Only incoming teletype messages which require transmission relay may be prepared for transmission using form 0-73. Use of form 0-73 is restricted to incoming teletype messages received within the last 3 days which require transmission relay; all other teletype messages must be prepared using form 0-93.
2. Additions such as notes and administrative data for a specific addressee are not allowed. If a note or administrative data is required for a particular addressee a separate 0-73 form must be prepared.
3. The message will be transmitted just as it appears. The person approving the message is solely responsible for assuring all necessary editing changes have been made.

PREPARATION OF FORM WHICH CONSISTS OF A PREPRINTED YELLOW.

1. Complete appropriate boxes: date, classification & precedence.
2. List addresses immediately following the "TO" or place a check mark in the appropriate boxes.
3. Type or PRINT the subject in the space provided.
4. Print or type originator's name, room number and telephone extension.
5. Indicate approval for transmission by initialing the "Approved By" box.

PREPARATION OF MESSAGE TO BE TRANSMITTED

1. Xerox 1 copy of incoming teletype message. A notation shall be made on the original incoming teletype "1 copy made for relay to SACS \_\_\_\_\_, (OR LEGATS) \_\_\_\_\_, (OR GOVERNMENT AGENCIES) \_\_\_\_\_".
2. Minor editing changes shall be made on the xerox as follows: using a lead pencil ONLY draw single line through the first and last lines of the heading and connect these lines from top right to bottom left forming a "Z," figure. (DO NOT OBLITERATE THE HEADING.) Use horizontal lines to delete sentences or words. Printed changes of a word or two to the text of the message may be made; however, changes to the existing text involving more than a word or two necessitate the originator to initiate a new message using form 0-93.
3. Administrative data or notes may be typed immediately following the text and will be transmitted to all addressees.
4. When using the 0-73 form to disseminate information to field offices, Legal Attaches and other Government agencies simultaneously, the text, notes and administrative data must be identical for all addressees.

For the information of the Bureau, SCHOFIELD is currently incarcerated at the Bexar County Jail, San Antonio, Texas, awaiting trial on a charge of murder. SCHOFIELD has previously been interviewed by FBI, San Antonio, on 8/12/77 at which time he alleged to have information that an attempt on the life of a prominent American would be made at Houston, Texas, at 5:25 p.m., on 8/22/77. He stated his source for this information was, "extra territorial." (u)

SCHOFIELD was again interviewed at the instructions of FBIHQ as a result of a letter SCHOFIELD had written to Attorney General GRIFFIN BELL alleging that he had information relative to a crime which was committed in another state. During this interview SCHOFIELD stated that the information he possessed concerned the Watergate breakin. SCHOFIELD stated he had previously been incarcerated at Bexar County Jail in December, 1971, and while incarcerated was made to agree to participate in the breakin of Democratic National Committee Headquarters in Washington, D. C. This information was furnished to FBIHQ in referenced LHM. (u)

In view of the fact that SCHOFIELD has been interviewed on 2 previous occasions and in view of the fact that he has been incarcerated for some time at Bexar County Jail, San Antonio Division will not interview SCHOFIELD relative to captioned RYMUR investigation, UACB. (u)

THE FBI TECHNICAL TEAM SENT TO GUYANA TO ASSIST LOCAL  
AUTHORITIES IN THE INVESTIGATION OF THE DEATH OF CONGRESSMAN  
RYAN HAS REVIEWED NUMEROUS DOCUMENTS TAKEN FROM JONESTOWN  
AND WHICH ARE CURRENTLY IN THE POSSESSION OF AMERICAN AMBASSA-  
DOR BURKE AT THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY, GEORGETOWN, GUYANA.  
THE DOCUMENTS ARE UNDER SEAL OF THE FBI. (u)

THIS IS TO ADVISE YOU THAT A REVIEW OF THE ABOVE DOCU-  
MENTS AS WELL AS SOME 400 TAPE RECORDINGS DISCLOSES THAT THEY  
REPRESENT POTENTIAL PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OF A POSSIBLE CRIMINAL  
CONSPIRACY TO KILL CONGRESSMAN RYAN, AND POSSIBLY OTHER CRIMES  
OVER WHICH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HAS PROSECUTIVE JURIS-  
DICTION SUCH AS INVOLUNTARY SERVITUDE AND INTERSTATE TRANSFER. (u)
