[redacted] was contacted immediately after his arrival aboard Pan American Airlines Flight Number 228 at the Pan American Airlines Terminal, John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFKIA), and advised of the identities of Special Agents (SAs) [redacted] Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), [redacted] and [redacted] United States (US) Secret Service. SA [redacted] advised [redacted] that the FBI and the US Secret Service were conducting an investigation into the assassination of US Congressman LEO RYAN on November 18, 1978, in Guyana (u)

[redacted] advised that he understood the nature of the investigation, but stated that before he made any comments, he wished to see his attorney, whom he believed present at JFKIA, and whom he identified as [redacted]. SA [redacted] advised [redacted] that arrangements would be made for [redacted] to speak with [redacted] and requested that he furnish on a voluntary basis, prior to meeting [redacted] background and descriptive data concerning himself. [redacted] stated that he had no objection to furnishing the above information and the following was obtained by observation and interview: (u)
