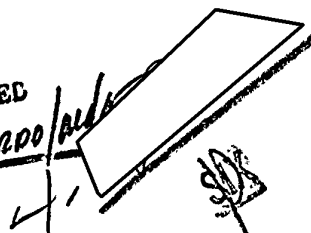

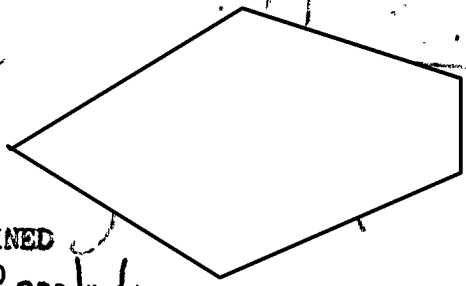

Special Agent Donald R. Hale, dated 5/27/81. (u)

For information of Bureau, Special Agent Hale met Lloyd
Rodney during crime scene trip to Jonestown, Guyana, South America,
in April, 1979. At that time, Rodney requested Legat (Caracas)
Robert Oglesby (retired) to furnish him Bureau material on finger-
print examination. (u)

At the time of this visit by FBI Special Agents, Rodney
identified himself as a fingerprint expert for the Guyana Police,
North West District, and was temporarily assigned as the legal
assistant to the Government of Guyana (GOG) Administrator (receiver)
of Peoples Temple property and assets in Guyana. His specific
responsibility was to oversee operations and property in Jonestown
in behalf of the GOG. Rodney acted as escort and guide for the
FBI Agents and was courteous, helpful, and complimentary towards
Agents and the FBI. (u)

Special Agent Hale has sent a personal note to Rodney
acknowledging his letter and advising him that it has been for-
warded to FBI HQ to more properly assist in his request. (u)


During my temporary assignment in Jones Town as an assistant administrator for the Guyana Government, immediately after the massacre, we spoke concerning my doing a research in finger prints, in U.S.A. I inquired about the possibility of visiting the F.B.I.

It is important that I give a brief rundown about my background. I am a graduate of the Institute of Applied Science U.S.A., and was a finger print expert attached to Demba Constabulary Guyana. I am now a law student at U.W.I. Barbados, and I will be doing my LL.B Finals in the academic year 1981-1982, I will be offering a special Thesis on the subject "Law in Society 11" under the caption of "Law and System of finger printing in Barbados and Guyana with special references to U.S.A."

I will like to visit the Federal Bureau of Investigation and other finger print agencies in order to complete my research. Please inform and advise as to what necessary approach to be adopted in order to obtain the relevant travelling document in this connection.
