COLONEL COWAN, AFIP, WALTER REED ARMY MEDICAL CENTER,
WASHINGTON, D. C. (WDC), WAS CONTACTED AM OF JANUARY 29,
1979, REGARDING THE CONTENTS OF THE FIRST SAN FRANCISCO
TELETYPE. COWAN INDICATED THAT ^{EX-121} DENNIS HAD BEEN
TENTATIVELY IDENTIFIED AND DENTAL RECORDS AND X-RAYS WOULD
BE OF ASSISTANCE. REC-80

REGARDING THE SECOND SAN FRANCISCO TELETYPE CONCERNING
HOUSE RECORDS, CONTACT WITH RYAN'S HOUSE OFFICE STAFF
DETERMINED THAT GALEN (JOE) HOLSINGER AND JACKIE SPIER
HAVE BOTH RESIGNED FROM THE STAFF AND ARE IN CALIFORNIA
RUNNING FOR THE VACANT HOUSE SEAT OF RYAN. JOE HOLSINGER
MADE AVAILABLE TO WASHINGTON FIELD ON DECEMBER 3, 1978,
THE RECORDS OF CONGRESSMAN RYAN REGARDING THE PT (REFER
TO WASHINGTON FIELD TELETYPES OF DECEMBER 5, 1978, AND
DECEMBER 8, 1978). THESE RECORDS HAVE BEEN SHIPPED TO
THE SAN FRANCISCO DIVISION BY AIRTEL FROM WASHINGTON FIELD
DATED JANUARY 29, 1979. HOLSINGER INDICATED THAT THE ONLY
THING HE REMOVED FROM RYAN'S BRIEFCASE, UPON DELIVERY TO
HIM BY JIM SCHOLLAERT, WAS A SUM OF MONEY. THE INTERVIEWING
AGENT HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF RELEASES SIGNED BY PT DEFECTORS,
AND DID NOT SPECIFICALLY ASK ABOUT THEM. JIM SCHOLLAERT
STATED HE RECEIVED THE BRIEFCASE FROM DICK DWYER AT
GEORGETOWN AND DELIVERED IT TO JOE HOLSINGER IN SAN

FRANCISCO AND DID NOT OPEN THE BRIEFCASE (REFER TO WASHINGTON
FIELD TELETYPE DECEMBER 7, 1978). HOLSINGER SAID HE DID

JIM SCHOLLAERT, HIRC, ADVISED JANUARY 29, 1979,
THERE ARE 37 MEMBERS ON THE FULL COMMITTEE AND SUGGESTED
PROCEEDING BY CONTACTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE FULL
COMMITTEE AND OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON PROTECTION OF
CITIZEN'S RIGHTS ABROAD OF WHICH RYAN WAS A MEMBER. ALSO
CONTACT THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA REPRESENTATIVES AND
REPRESENTATIVES OF LOS ANGELES AND UKIAH, CALIFORNIA.
