As was discussed in the meeting of January 5, 1979, between Associate Attorney General Michael Egan, United States Attorney William Hunter, San Francisco, yourself, your staff, and representatives of the FBI, the criminal investigation that you have requested has already been implemented. All field offices have been alerted to potential violations involving the Peoples Terple. All field offices have been instructed to promptly investigate all allegations coming to our attention involving FBI jurisdiction. Our field offices have also been instructed to promptly advise identifiable potential victims of threats received, and render appropriate dissemination of information to Federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies. M Your request that this Eureau conduct a limited domestic security investigation is being held in abeyance pending the conclusion of our ongoing criminal investigation. All matters involving the Peoples Temple that would be addresmed by such an investigation are currently being explored in the criminal inquiry. At the conclusion of the criminal investigation, an assessment will be made as to the need to iditiate a limited domestic security investigation of the Peoples Temple. (71) [REC-47.
