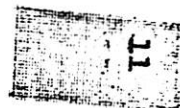

On December 1, 1978, Special Agents (SAs) [redacted] and ROBERT J. OGLESBY, JR. of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) reviewed 22 cassette recordings made available by [redacted] Guyana National Police (GNP), at Central Intelligence Division (CID) Headquarters, Georgetown, Guyana. Of these 22 tapes, 12 of them were blank, six contained music and unknown people talking, two were broken, one had Guyana radio newscasts and one which had previously been blank was reported on by GNP. (u)

None of the above cassette tapes contained any information deemed pertinent by SAs [redacted] and OGLESBY. (u)
