On 12/4/78, SAs [redacted] and ROBERT J. OGLESBY listened to approximately forty-two cassette tape recordings which had been made available to them by Assistant Superintendent of Police CECIL A. ROBERTS, Guyanise National Police (GNP) (u)

The majority of the above cassettes were either blank or contained music and/or unknown people in conversation. One of the above conversations was a telephone conversation between Reverend JAMES W. JONES and one MARVIN SWEENEY. A copy of this cassette was made by SA [redacted] (u)

SAs [redacted] and OGLESBY also noted that there were approximately one hundred seven-inch reels of tape in custody of the GNP. All of the above tapes were examined by SAs [redacted] and OGLESBY for any markings that would distinguish them from other tapes. It was also noted that there were six reels of tape approximately eighteen inches in diameter in custody of GNP. One of the seven-inch reels was in a box marked "WHITE NIGHT." A cassette copy of this seven-inch reel was made by SA [redacted] (u)
