[redacted] North Shore Hospital, Manhasset, Long Island (LI), telephonically contacted the Queens Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and furnished the following information: (u)

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[redacted] advised that he was patched through to Jonestown, Guyana by [redacted] of New Hyde Park, New York (NY), during approximately May of 1978. [redacted] stated that he does not recall, but he believes he spoke directly to Doctor SCHACHT about a patient, and Doctor SCHACHT was seeking medical advice. [redacted] stated that he diagnosed the problem as low blood sugar, possibly a tumor of the pancreas. [redacted] stated that he asked about the patient, because he believed the patient should be moved to a hospital immediately. [redacted] was told that the patient was one of the leaders and didn't want to leave. [redacted] stated that he believes he had only one or two conversations with Jonestown. (u)

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[redacted] advised that he never heard whether the patient was cured or not. He stated that he thinks he wrote a letter to Jonestown asking about the patient, however, he is sure that he never received a reply. (u)

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[redacted] advised that he could furnish no additional information. (u)
