DREFUS AND MC TURNLAND, MARKET STREET, SAN FRANCISCO. (u/

HOWEVER, INGRAM DID STATE THAT HE HAD BEEN RESTRICTED
TO THE CONFINES OF HIS HOME IN GUYANA AT GUNPOINT FOR 17 DAYS
BUT FAILED TO PINPOINT THE TIME PERIOD AND TO IDENTIFY HIS
CAPTORS. HE STATED THAT HE DEPARTED GUYANA THE AFTERNOON OF
DECEMBER 21, 1979, EN ROUTE TO MIAMI AND THEN SAN FRANCISCO.

AT APPROXIMATELY 13:45 P.M., FEBRUARY 21, 1979, BUREAU AGENTS LOCATED INGRAM IN THE LOBBY AREA OF MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. HE STATED THAT HE HAD MISSED HIS FLIGHT AS A RESULT OF BEING INTERVIEWED AND THAT HE EXPECTED THE BUREAU TO PROVIDE HIM OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS. HE WAS TOLD THAT THE INTERVIEW WAS CONCLUDED PRIOR TO HIS PREARRANGED FLIGHT AND THAT HIS REQUEST COULD NOT BE HONORED (u)

FOR INFORMATION OF SAN FRANCISCO, MARION LEE INGRAM IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BLACK MALE, DOB [REDACTED] IN NEW YORK, NEW YORK, 6'1", 175 POUNDS, BLACK HAIR, BLACK FULL BEARD, WEARING TINTED EYEGLASSES, AND CLOTHED IN A BLACK SHIRT AND BLACK BELL-BOTTOM TROUSERS. HE IS PERSONALLY CARRYING A BROWN LEATHER, SQUARE SHAPED BRIEF BAG AND IS IN POSSESSION OF LUGGAGE WHICH INCLUDES A FLOWER PATTERN FABRIC SUITCASE AND A SMALL PINK COLORED STUFF BAG. (u)
