[Redacted] New York, [Redacted] advised she recently
returned from Houston, Texas and had located her husband,
captioned individual, at his apartment, [Redacted]
[Redacted] Texas, telephone number [Redacted]. She
ascertained from him that he had been on a trip to visit
his adopted parents in Denver, Colorado area and was a
victim of a vehicular accident enroute home, in which he
totaled his new Datsun Pick-up Truck. She claims that
he suffered financial reverses through his company and
tried to meet his payroll demands out of their household
budget. [Redacted] claims her husband is still
confused about religion but is recovering from his depression
and she eventually looks forward to rejoining him.
