Upon his arrival at John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK), aboard Pan American Airlines Flight 321 from Georgetown, Guyana, **STEPHEN CAROL JONES** furnished the following information: (u)

JONES advised that he had arrived in Guyana approximately two years ago and went immediately to Jonestown. **JONES** advised that he was kept at Jonestown against his will until November 6, 1978 when he went to Georgetown to participate in the basketball tournament. (u)

A review of United States Passport #26773687 in the name of **STEPHEN G. JONES** which expired December 4, 1978, showed no entries after 1977 entrance into Guyana. (u)

A review of United States Passport #3306975, issued February 27, 1979, showed exit from Guyana February 27, 1979 as the only entry made in the passport. (u)

STEPHEN GANDHI JONES was interviewed in the presence of Special Agent [redacted] United States (US) Secret Service, upon his arrival at John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFKIA), aboard Pan Am Flight 228, from Georgetown, Guyana. JONES furnished the following information: (u)

JONES stated that he did not wish to talk to the agents until he has had an opportunity to speak with an attorney first. JONES stated that at this time, he does not have his own attorney. JONES stated that he wanted to be fully cooperative with the government, however, he would like to have an opportunity to speak with an attorney first. (u)

JONES voluntarily advised that he had gone to Jonestown, Guyana, approximately two years ago. JONES stated that he was supposed to go down there for a couple of days, however, when he arrived, his father, Reverend JIM JONES, stated that he wanted him to stay there. (u)

JONES advised that the only other S. JONES that he knew in Guyana was SANDNY JONES, a deceased sister-in-law that had worked in the medical unit (u)
