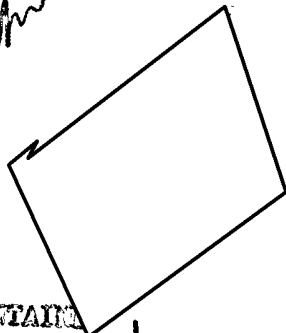

AUSA, SAN FRANCISCO REQUESTS TO EXPEDITE THE OBTAINING OF GUYANA POLICE INTERVIEWS OF [REDACTED] [REDACTED] MIKE PROKES AS PREVIOUSLY REQUESTED. ABOVE INDIVIDUALS HAVE REFUSED ANY STATEMENTS TO THE FBI OR FEDERAL GRAND JURY AND STATEMENTS MADE BY ABOVE INDIVIDUALS ARE THE ONLY EXISTING EXPLANATION OF THEIR ACTIVITIES IN GUYANA. AUSA REALIZES STATEMENTS MADE TO POLICE AND STATEMENTS AT CORONER'S INQUEST ARE ESSENTIALLY THE SAME, HOWEVER, ANY DIFFERENCES, ADDITIONS, OR DELETIONS IN COMPARING STATEMENTS ARE MOST SIGNIFICANT IN HIS GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS.
