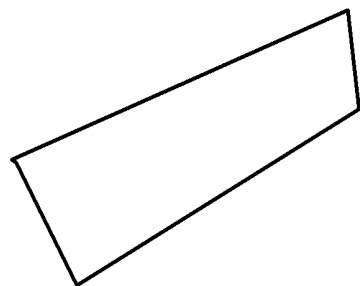

1. IN MEETING WITH ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF POLICE ROBERTS  
ON MARCH 15, DCM REQUESTED TRANSCRIPTS OF TESTIMONY OF  
PEOPLE'S TEMPLE MEMBERS TAKEN BY GUYANESE POLICE AND, IN  
PARTICULAR, OF TIMOTHY AND MICHAEL CARTER AND MICHAEL PROKES.  
ROBERTS ACKNOWLEDGED THAT HE HAD PROMISED THIS MATERIAL TO THE  
FBI, REGRETTED THAT HE HAD NOT PASSED IT ON EARLIER, AND
