In the course of investigation, RYMUR, information developed the existence of a cave in Mendocino County alleged to contain People's Temple documents, money, and/or firearms. Search conducted 4/10-13/79. (u)

FBI coordinated with DOE and Lawrence Radiation Laboratory, Livermore, California, which furnished sophisticated photographic monitoring equipment and heavy-duty two ton truck (no charge) to assist in search of cave located by the FBI in rural mountainous area currently being used as range land. Consent to search was obtained from owner and resulted in transporting truck to obscure area, negotiation of narrow dirt road, and necessitated crossing approximately 300 yards of range feeding land. Truck operated by DOE became stuck in mud and was required to be winched out. Range was also traveled by numerous 4-wheel drive vehicles necessary in search and to bring in timbers and other materials to site to be used to construct platform to facilitate search. Traffic caused considerable damage to range land and necessitated owner to have area leveled by heavy-duty cat and reseeded. (u)

On 8/14/79, owner of property, [redacted] Redwood Valley, California, 95470, submitted receipts for correction of damage caused by search. Receipts include total of \$221.30 for seed and fertilizer and \$285.00 for 9½ hours back hoe at \$30 an hour. Back hoe includes heavy-duty cat and operator. (u)
