NOTE:

Mr. Castillo was one of several hundred victims of cyanide poisoning in the Jonestown, Guyana massacre. His remains were one of seven chosen at random by the FBI for autopsy upon request of the Department of Justice. The autopsies were conducted by the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology. Prior consent for the autopsies was obtained from next of kin of chosen victims. Several relatives of the victims on whom these autopsies were performed requested copies of the reports on the results of the examinations. With prior Departmental approval, these copies were forwarded.

Mr. Roybal's assistant had previously phoned SA [Redacted] about the matter as he had handled previous autopsy matters while assigned to the Rymur Special at FBIHQ. Passage of the autopsy report on Mr. Castillo was discussed with Mr. Mike Abbell, International Affairs Office, DOJ and State Department, who interposed no objection to the above. (u)
