1. Only incoming teletype messages which require transmission relay may be prepared for transmission using form 0-73. Use of form 0-73 is restricted to incoming teletype messages received within the last 3 days which require transmission relay; all other teletype messages must be prepared using form 0-93.
2. Additions such as notes and administrative data for a specific addressee are not allowed. If a note or administrative data is required for a particular addressee a separate 0-73 form must be prepared.
3. The message will be transmitted just as it appears. The person approving the message is solely responsible for assuring all necessary editing changes have been made.

PREPARATION OF MESSAGE TO BE TRANSMITTED

1. Xerox 1 copy of incoming teletype message. A notation shall be made on the original incoming teletype "1 copy made for relay to SACS \_\_\_\_\_, (OR LEGATS) \_\_\_\_\_, (OR GOVERNMENT AGENCIES) \_\_\_\_\_."
2. Minor editing changes shall be made on the xerox as follows: using a lead pencil ONLY draw single line through the first and last lines of the heading and connect these lines from top right to bottom left forming a "Z," figure. (DO NOT OBLITERATE THE HEADING.) Use horizontal lines to delete sentences or words. Printed changes of a word or two to the text of the message may be made; however, changes to the existing text involving more than a word or two necessitate the originator to initiate a new message using form 0-93.
3. Administrative data or notes may be typed immediately following the text and will be transmitted to all addressees.
4. When using the 0-73 form to disseminate information to field offices, Legal Attaches and other Government agencies simultaneously, the text, notes and administrative data must be identical for all addressees.

IN RESPONSE TO IMMEDIATE TELETYPE FROM LEGAT, BOGOTA, AMERICAN EMBASSY, AT GEORGETOWN, GUYANA, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS: EMBASSY HAS NOW OBTAINED COPY OF THE WRITTEN CONFESSION OF MR. LARRY LAYTON WITH REGARD TO THE NOVEMBER 18, 1978, MURDERS OF CONGRESSMAN LEO RYAN AND OTHERS AT PORT KAITUMA, GUYANA, AS INDICATED REF (A), AS GIVEN TO THE GUYANESE POLICE IN GEORGETOWN ON NOVEMBER 22, 1978. LAYTON APPARENTLY ALSO MADE A VERBAL CONFESSION WHILE IN POLICE CUSTODY IN PORT KAITUMA. EMBASSY HAS REQUESTED, AGAIN, A COPY OF THE POLICE OFFICER'S STATEMENT REGARDING THIS ORAL CONFESSION, WHICH WILL BE TRANSMITTED AS SOON AS RECEIVED.

LAYTON AGE 32 YEARS AN EX-RAY TECHNICAN OF CALIFORNIA, UNITED STATES. YOU ARE NOT OBLIGED TO SAY ANYTHING UNLESS YOU WISH TO DO SO BUT WHAT YOU SAY MAY BE PUT INTO WRITING AND GIVEN IN EVIDENCE. A. SMITH D/A.S.P. (SGD.) LARRY J. LAYTON I LARRY LAYTON, WISH TO MAKE A STATEMENT. I WANT SOMEONE TO WRITE DOWN WHAT I SAY. I HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT I NEED NOT SAY ANTHING UNLESS I WISH TO DO DO AND THAT WHATEVER I SAY MAY BE GIVEN IN EVIDENCE. A. SMITH D/A. S.P. (SGD.) LARRY J. LAYTON I MAKE THIS STATEMENT OF MY OWN FREE WILD. I WISH TO DO SO AND THAT WHATEVER I SAY MAY BE GIVEN IN EVIDENCE. I LARRY LAYTON TAKE FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL THE DEATHS AND INJURIES THAT TOOK PLACE AT THE PORT KAITUMA AIRSTRIP. I HAD BEGGED THE BISHOP JIM JONES THAT I BE ALLOWED TO BRING DOWN THE PLANE BUT HE DISAPPROVED, MY REASON FOR SUPPORTING THIS WAS BECAUSE I FELT THAT THOSE PEOPLE WERE WORKING IN CONJUNCTION WITH C.I.A. TO SMEAR THE PEOPLE'S TEMPLE AND TO SMEAR GUYANA. I GOT A GUN FROM A FRIEND OF MINE ONE PANCHO AND I WENT TO THE AIRPORT INTENDING TO BRING DOWN THE PLANE, BUT WHEN THE SHOOTING STARTED, I ALSO STARTED SHOOTING AS I THOUGHT IT WAS ALL TOO LATE. A. SAME WAS READ OVER TO AND BY LARRY LAYTON WHO SAID IT IS TRUE AND CORRECT AND SIGNED HIS NAME TO IT IN MY PRESENCE AND THAT OF DED. ASST. SJPT. SMITH JAGMOHAN DEPT. INSP.

EMBASSY AT GEORGETOWN ALSO ADVISED THAT OTHER MATERIAL REQUIRED BY ATTORNEY ALFRED HANIMAN HAS ALREADY BEEN REQUESTED BY DEPARTMENT OF STATE PRESUMABLY AT REQUEST OF JUSTICE, AND THERE HAVE BEEN A SERIES OF MEETINGS OF STATE ON JUSTICE ON THE SUBJECT. WASHINGTON HAS SUGGESTED, FOR EXAMPLE, THAT A LIASON PERSON FROM WASHINGTON (PRESUMABLY FROM JUSTICE) BE SENT TO CONSULT WITH PROSECUTION BEFORE LAYTON PRELIMINARY INQUIRY BEGINS OCTOBER 29 AND GUYANESE HAVE CONCURRED. WE WOULD THEREFORE PREFER THAT JUSTICE REQUESTS BE TRANSMITTED TO US THROUGH STATE TO INSURE THAT BOTH ARE FULLY INFORMED.

WILL INSURE THAT OUR TRAFFIC ON THIS SUBJECT IS REPEATED TO YOU TO KEEP YOU UP TO DATE AS WELL. (W)
