DETAILS: [Redacted] advised our San Francisco Office that at approximately 9:30 p.m., on ~~2/26/80~~ Deceased 2/26/80, Al Joseph Mills and Jeannie Mills were fatally shot, and their sixteen year-old daughter, Daphne, critically wounded in their residence at Berkeley, California. The daughter has since died as a result of the wounds received. Mills - B. 11/20/1964 (u)

Present at the residence at the time of the murders was the seventeen year-old stepson, Eddie Mills. Eddie Mills was unharmed and disclaims any knowledge or involvement in the murders. (u) CA.
