GUYANA

1. AFTER TWO AND ONE HALF HOURS OF DELIBERATION, THE JURY IN THE TRIAL OF US CITIZEN LAWRENCE LAYTON FOR ATTEMPTED MURDER BROUGHT IN A VERDICT OF NOT GUILTY ON ALL FOUR COUNTS OF THE INDICTMENT. THE JURY HAD VOTED 10 - 2 TO ACQUIT ON EACH OF THE FOUR COUNTS AGAINST LAYTON.

2. FOLLOWING THE VERDICT, PROSECUTING ATTORNEY V. PERSAUD INFORMED EMBOFF THAT LAYTON WOULD REMAIN IN CUSTODY UNTIL THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS (DPP) DECIDED WHETHER OR NOT TO PROCEED AGAINST LAYTON WITH CHARGES OF MURDER AND CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT MURDER.
