1. ON SEPTEMBER 15, EMBASSY POLOFF CONTACTED ASSISTANT  
DIRECTIONS OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS (DPP) GEORGET JACKMAN ON  
SUBJECT CASE. JACKMAN STATED THAT DPP EMMANUEL RAMOA HAD  
DECIDED TO EXPEL LAYTON FROM GUYANA. ACCORDING TO JACKMAN,  
LAYTON WILL BE GIVEN A CHOICE OF EITHER REMAINING IN PRISION  
FOR AN INDEFINITE PERIOD UNTIL "WE GET AROUND TO HIM" OR  
BOARDING A PLACE FOR THE U.S.

2. JACKMAN SAID THAE GOG WISHED TO KNOW IF THE USG WOULD  
PAY FOR LAYTON'S PASSAGE AND ARRANGE TRANSPORTATION. HE  
SAID THAT LAYTON WOULD BE EXPELLED ON A DATE CHOSEN BY  
THE USG, BUT HOPED THAT IT WOULD BE WITHIN THREE WEEKS.

3. PLEASE ADVISE ON ABOVE AND ON WHETHER AN ESCORT  
OFFICER WILL BE COMING HERE TO ACCOMPANY LAYTON BACK  
TO THE U.S.
