- 3. LAYTON'S ATTORNEY INFORMED DPP THAT EITHER PARENTS WOULD SEND FUNDS FOR SUBJECT'S TICKET OR THEY WOULD COME TO GEORGETOWN AND GO BACK WITH THEIR SON.
- 4. A CONSULAR OFFICER WILL BE MAKING A MONTHLY PRISION VISIT ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24. AT THAT TIME LAYTON WILL BE REQUESTED TO COMPLETE A PASSPORT APPLICATION FORM. LPON COMPLETION OF THE FORM AND SUBMISSION OF PROTOGRAPHS, EMBBASSY WILL ISSUE A CARD OF IDENTITY, WHILM WILL BE HELD AT THE EMBASSY UNTIL LAYTON'S RELASE AND DEPARTURE FROM GUYANA.
- 5. EMBASSY WEEDS TO KNOW ASAP ANSWERS TO THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:
- (A) 51 NCE THE DEPARTMENT IS AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF A CARD OF IDENTITY AND NOT A PASSPORT, DOES THE EMBASSY COLLECT \$3.20 (THREE DOLLARS) FOR A CARD OF IDENTITY, OR WOOLD IT BE A NO FEE TRANSACTION?
- (B) 5mOULD LAYTON'S ATTORNEY PRESS FOR ISSUANCE OF A FASSPORT INSTEAD OF A CARD OF IDENTITY, WHAT REPLY SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE ATTORNEY?
- (C) WILL JUSTICE BE SENDING AN ESCORT OFFICER TO ACCOMPANY SUBJECT BACK TO U.S.?
