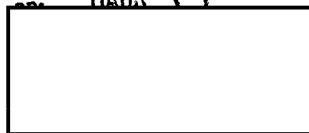

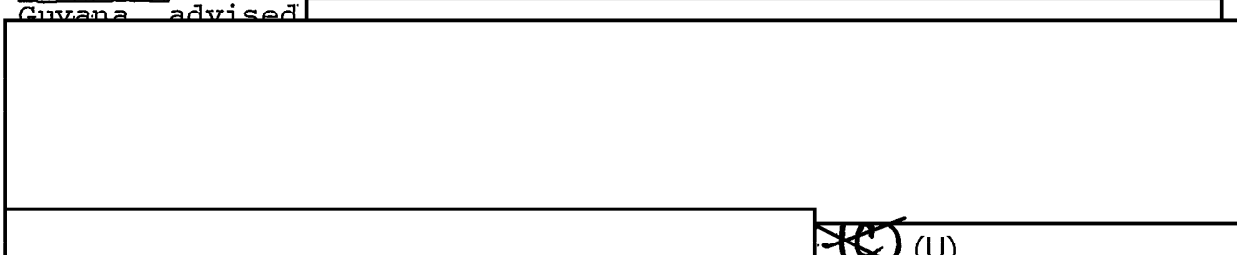

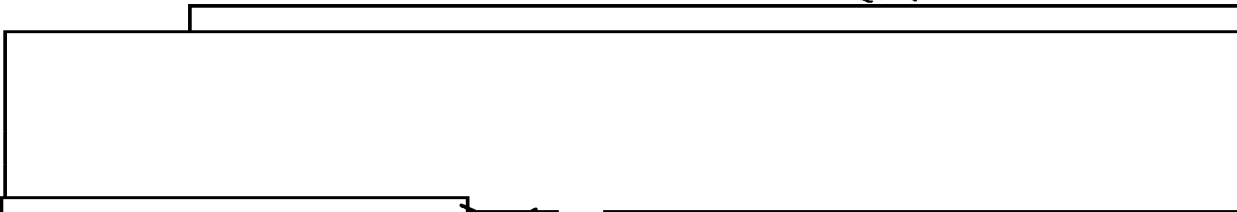

On 9/19/80, Roger Cabbage, Departmental Attorney, General Litigation and Legal Advice Section, Criminal Division, Department of Justice (DOJ), WDC, advised that the DOJ is conferring with the United States Attorney, Northern District of California, regarding the prosecution of Layton in the United States. Mr. Cabbage advised that, pending prosecutive decisions in this matter, the DOJ is considering directing a letter to FBIHQ requesting that arrangements be made by the FBI for Layton's transportation to the United States and for Layton to be escorted to the United States by Agents of the FBI.
