ADVISED THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF GUYANA (GOG) WILL DISMISS OUTSTANDING GUYANA MURDER CHARGE AGAINST SUBJECT AND EXPEL HIM FROM GUYANA. LAYTON HAS BEEN DETAINED IN GUYANA BY RESTRAINING ORDER RESULTING FROM A CIVIL ACTION BY HIS DEFENSE ATTORNEY ALLEGING AN INDEBTEDNESS OF \$37,000. HIGH COURT IN GUYANA HAS UPHELD INDEBTEDNESS BUT ON NOVEMBER 6, 1980, DISMISSED RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST LAYTON. AMERICAN EMBASSY, GEORGETOWN, ADVISED THAT THEY ARE CURRENTLY TO MEET WITH THE DPP TO FACILITATE THE EXPULSION OF LAYTON FROM GUYANA AT THE EARLIEST MUTUALLY CONVENIENT DATE. DPP HAS REITERATED THAT THEY HAVE NO INTENTION OF ALLOWING LAYTON "LOOSE ON THE STREETS". IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT GUYANA CHARGES WILL BE DISMISSED AND LAYTON WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THE COUNTRY AT THE SAME TIME. AMERICAN EMBASSY, GEORGETOWN, ADVISED THEY WOULD KEEP FBI, SAN FRANCISCO, ADVISED

FOR INFORMATION OF MIAMI, MOST CONVENIENT DIRECT
ROUTE FROM GUYANA TO THE UNITED STATES IS VIA GUYANESE
AIRLINE CORPORATION FROM GEORGETOWN TO MIAMI. (u)

US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE HAS ADVISED THAT US MARSHAL
IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION AND ARREST OF LAYTON. MIAMI
IS BEING ADVISED IN VIEW OF THE FACT THAT LAYTON WILL MOST
LIKELY BE ARRESTED IN MIAMI AND SHOULD BE AFFORDED HEARING
BEFORE US MAGISTRATE PRIOR TO EXTRADITION TO CALIFORNIA.

SAN FRANCISCO WILL KEEP BUREAU AND MIAMI ADVISED OF
