AT PRETRIAL HEARING APRIL 1, 1981, AT SAN FRANCISCO, TRIAL
SCHEDULED FOR LARRY LAYTON ON MAY 12, 1981, HAS BEEN
POSTPONED TO JULY 9, 1981, AT THE REQUEST OF DEFENSE AND
OVER OBJECTION OF THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE. DEFENSE
HAS BEEN UNABLE TO OBTAIN PSYCHIATRIST. DEFENSE HAS TWICE
FAILED TO COMPLY WITH JUDGE'S ORDER IN THIS REGARD. EVEN THOUGH
JUDGE ADMONISHED DEFENSE AND SCHEDULED ADDITIONAL PRETRIAL
HEARING FOR APRIL 20, 1981, FOR FURTHER DISCUSSIONS, HE DID
ACQUIESCE IN DEFENSE PLEA FOR CONTINUANCE AND TRIAL IS
RESCHEDULED FOR JULY 9, 1981. JUDGE ALSO SET PRETRIAL HEARING
ON JULY 7, 1981, TO DISCUSS DEFENSE MOTION TO SUPPRESS SIGNED

CONFESSION OF LARRY LAYTON. (u)

IT IS NOT ANTICIPATED THAT GUYANA WITNESSES' PRESENCE WILL BE REQUESTED ON JULY 7, 1981, FOR PRETRIAL HEARING ON MOTION TO SUPPRESS CONFESSION. WITNESSES WOULD THEREAFTER BE REQUESTED TO REMAIN UNTIL TESTIMONY AT TRIAL THE FOLLOWING WEEK. THESE GOVERNMENT WITNESSES WOULD INCLUDE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF CRIMES CECIL (SKIP) ROBERTS, SUPERINTENDENT ALVIN SMITH, INSPECTOR JAGMAHON, SUPERNUMERARY CONSTABLE MORTIMER KANSIN ALLY, AND PORT KAITUMA CITIZEN JOEL CLEMENTSON. DR. LESLIE MOOTOO'S PRESENCE WOULD BE REQUESTED DURING THE WEEK OF JULY 13, 1981. (u)

FOR THE INFORMATION OF STATE AND AMERICAN EMBASSY, GEORGETOWN, THE FBI HAS LEARNED THAT DEFENSE ATTORNEYS, WHICH WILL INCLUDE ASSISTANT PUBLIC DEFENDER FRANK BELL AND ATTORNEY ANTHONY TAMBURELLO, ANTICIPATE TRAVEL TO GUYANA THIS MONTH. EXACT DATES OF TRAVEL UNKNOWN, HOWEVER, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THEY WILL DEPART SAN FRANCISCO AROUND APRIL 9 AND RETURN APRIL 20, 1981. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE WILL CONTACT STATE AND AMERICAN EMBASSY DIRECT. (u)
