ON SEPTEMBER 13, 1982, UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS, NINTH DISTRICT, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA (THREE PANEL JUDGE) WILL HEAR ORAL ARGUMENTS ON GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO REVERSE EVIDENTIARY MATTERS DENIED BY TRIAL JUDGE. (u)
